

## Team Grade for LIB 103 (15% of Final Grade)

The team grade is based on 2 components:

### 1) Completion of team activities (worth 8 points)

### 2) Your teammates' and instructor's perceptions of your contribution to the team activities (worth 7 points)

Completion of each of the following activities is worth **1 point for each activity**.

"Hey! Why all this work for only 1 point?" These in class activities are used for **your learning** and for the instructor to **assess your learning**.

Activities you have completed are listed on your grade status report. Grade status reports are passed out or e-mailed to you periodically. If you have that activity listed on your status report you have received 1 point for that activity.

The remaining **7 points** will be based on your teammates' perceptions of your contribution to the team. Your instructor will also consider her observations of your participation as well for this component of your grade.

At the end of the semester you will be asked to give your teammates a "grade" based on your perception of their contribution to the team activity.

**7 points** = Consistently contributed to the team activities throughout the semester. This teammate was always in class and did his/her share of the work and was willing to do more if needed. This teammate took the lead in many team activities and made sure our team got the assignment done. Similar to an "A."

**5 points** = Consistently contributed to the team activities throughout the semester. This teammate was always in class and did his/her share of the work. Similar to a "B."

**3 points** = Contributed to the team activities when he/she was in class but was not always here. Similar to a "C."

**1 points** = Was in class and sat with team but relied on other team members to complete assignments. Similar to a "D."

**0 points** = Was hardly ever in class on days with team activities or relied completely on other team members to complete assignments and did not assist teammates. Similar to a "F."
