<p>I am required to attend class. The majority of teaching and learning happens in the classroom. I understand that if I do not attend class, I cannot participate and I miss important information. Missing more than 3 classes will result in my final grade being lowered a letter grade for each additional absence. I understand that the attendance policy is enforced beginning the first day after the drop/add period ends (9/27/09). I understand that there are no "excused" absences. <p>I am responsible for any material I miss in class. I will need to consult classmates for missed materials.</p>	<p>Initial: _____</p>
<p>I will come to class on time. I understand that class will not be restarted for me if I am late.</p>	<p>Initial: _____</p>
<p>I understand that missed tests can only be "made up" under two circumstances: 1) If I know prior to the test date that I will be forced to miss the exam, I may schedule an appointment with my instructor to take the test PRIOR to the test date. 2) If I have a family emergency or serious illness on the day of an exam, I must contact my instructor at least four hours prior to the test time to make arrangements to take the test.</p>	<p>Initial: _____</p>
<p>I am expected to actively participate in each class session. This includes active listening, participating in class discussions and activities, and respecting my instructor and classmates. Should I fail to meet these expectations I will be asked to leave class and will be considered absent.</p>	<p>Initial: _____</p>
<p>I understand that due dates for assignments are firm. Assignments are due at the beginning of class on the date due. Those assignments received during, or after class, will be considered one day late. I will lose 1 point (1% of my final grade) on my assignment for each day late. I understand that I cannot "make up" assignments later in the semester. Assignments submitted on my course blog (News Reports and Reading Reports) must be posted before the beginning of class on the date due. I understand I should not use class time to complete these assignments as they will be considered late.</p>	<p>Initial: _____</p>
<p>I will put my cell phone on silent mode and only answer if absolutely necessary (e.g. monitoring a family emergency). I understand that I am expected to leave the classroom if I must take a call.
