Executive Council Meeting with CTE Director
June 15, 2006
9:00 - 10:00 a.m., CTE office

In attendance: Tricia Kelley, Tom Schmid; CTE Director Carrie Clements

Members of Executive Council met with Center for Teaching Excellence Director Carrie Clements to discuss ELC plans and how CTE might become involved in the program.

Aspects of the program with which CTE could help:

- Teaching initiatives
 - CC willing to commit to support of teaching initiatives as shown in draft budget
 - Will also require approval of CTE advisory board
- Student assistance – CTE may be able to assist in this area
- Travel funds
 - CTE has funds available to support travel to teaching-related events (<\$300/request)
 - Travel to Appalachian State to develop collaboration would be eligible
 - ELC needs to submit specific travel request to CC (budgeting done during summer)
- CTE can help forge partnerships with other units to support ELC activities
 - Library has funds for displays/showcases (need 1 yr lead time; contact Sue Cody or Sherman Hayes office)
 - Film series – possible funding from CTE, CFL, Honors, General College
 - 1-week seminar for UNCW faculty on evolution (anticipated to cost \$10k) – CTE could help develop partnerships to fund (e.g., Chancellor's office)
 - If scholarly conference focused on undergraduates, possible funding from CSURF, Sigma Xi, Honors, SGA
- Other possible funding partners to bring into discussion
 - Library
 - Provost's office (Raymond Burt/Gay Howe for state vehicle to ASU)
 - Mary Gornto (VC University Advancement)/Mimi Cunningham (Univ. Relations)
 - Steve Demski (VC Public Service & Continuing Studies) – community partnerships
 - Donna Chapa Crowe (Center Leadership Education and Service) – for activities related to service learning
 - Kemille Moore/Terry Curran re Learning Communities
