Executive Council discussed the following issues:

Gessner request to increase level of support for Visiting Darwin Scholar David Quammen

- Original funding request by CRW to bring Quammen to campus was not sufficient to cover his expenses; Gessner requested additional funding from Provost's allocation to ELC for Visiting Darwin Scholars
- Executive Council decided to increase support for Quammen to \$5000
- PK will inform Gessner

ELC publicity

- Brochure/flyer listing ELC-related courses for AY 08-09
  - Gessner had suggested CRW publications lab could develop a brochure
  - Two-sided flyer would be preferable to tri-fold brochure (which we already have for ELC)
  - One side should list fall 08 courses and other side should list the spring 09 courses; both sides should list the ELC website
  - PK will contact Gessner to have publications lab work on flyer
  - In meantime TS will produce a poster listing courses for immediate distribution across campus (CV to help post)
- CV suggested ELC bulletin board – perhaps in library?
- DM suggested greater involvement of UNCW clubs in ELC (ELC does have SGA representative now)

Burney Center fee for student conference

- Burney Center is charging fee of \$1300/day for student conference
- Fee is charged because we are planning to charge registration fee
- Unclear what policy states
  - If sponsored by student organization, is fee waived?
  - If no registration fee charged, but meal tickets are sold instead, is fee waived?
- CV has emailed Amanda Turner for clarification
- TS has spoken with Carolyn Farley and Tina Strickland; PK has been working with Manny Avalos
- No resolution yet [This was later resolved by Provost Hosier agreeing to pay the fee for ELC, and having the opening event at CMS]
