

## **UNC System Libraries Recent Key Successes**

### **Appalachian State University**

- Establishment of two endowments: Mary and Nancy Lee Bivens Distinguished Professorship for Children and Reading; and the Bivens University Library Fund for Excellence.

### **East Carolina University**

- Creation of 5,000 s.f. Learning Cove for Project STEPP (Supporting Transition and Education through Planning and Partnership).

### **Elizabeth City State University**

- Permission to fill 4 vacant positions.

### **Fayetteville State University**

- Implementation of the Librarian/Faculty Information Literacy Collaborative, successfully incorporating Association of College and Research Libraries Standards for Information Literacy into course syllabi.

### **North Carolina A&T**

### **North Carolina Central University**

- Implementation of online subject guides, enhancing awareness of and access to library's intellectual content through the use of Libguides software; accomplished in response to LibQual survey, continuous improvement assessment tool.

### **North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics**

### **North Carolina State University**

- In FY 2012/13, NCSU will open its new James B. Hunt Library, one of the very top engineering, textiles, and science libraries of its kind in the world.

### **University of North Carolina at Asheville**

- Extension of hours of operation by 5% during a period of staff retrenchment (34%), while maintaining same level of collections expenditures.

### **University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill**

- Establishment of the North Carolina Digital Heritage Center, providing free or low-cost digitization and online hosting services for cultural heritage institutions around the state.

### **University of North Carolina at Charlotte**

- Aggressive move to digital scholarship programs has precluded the need for new, additional library space; renovations for new student learning spaces.

### **University of North Carolina at Greensboro**

- Major renovations of space for Special Collections and University Archives areas.

**University of North Carolina at Pembroke**

- Major outreach through digitization of thousands of photographic negatives of regional interest.

**University of North Carolina School of the Arts**

**University of North Carolina at Wilmington**

- Enhancements/renovations to physical and virtual spaces: group studies, “galley space;” iPhone applications.

**Western Carolina University**

- Implementation of new generation search discovery tool, EBSCO EDS; learning space renovations; new, additional entrances/exits; digital program initiatives.

**Winston- Salem State University**

- Major building renovations: learning commons; media production lab; and group study spaces.
